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If absenteeism in Warren County Public Schools is sufficient enough to warrant closure of our schools, the expectation is our students will continue to have their educational needs supported. We recommend that families have basic school supplies (pencils, notebook or notebook paper, scissors, glue, crayons/colored pencils, highlighters, etc.) on hand in case this is necessary. If you need any of these supplies at home, please contact your child's teacher as soon as possible. If you are not connected to your child's classroom teacher through Class Dojo, we recommend creating your account now. Following is an outline of alternative procedures to assure continuity of instruction in the event of extended school closures.

Our teachers will provide various assignments and resources through which our students can continue to access their grade level curriculum. If school is to be closed for an extended period of time, work will be available for students for completion during the time of the school closure.

## **Alternate Options for Home-Based Instruction:**

Questions regarding school work during an extended absence or closure should be directed first to the teacher, then to the school office.

**Kindergarten Plan:**

Our team will utilize the kindergarten website to share out a calendar with a list of assignments and links to complete each day. Assignments will consist of videos, worksheets, hands-on learning suggestions, links to specific games and Brainpop videos. Using the website parents can also access links to specific learning songs, review powerpoints and games. Checking for understanding will occur upon return with our end of advisory assessments.

### **1st Grade Plan:**

Our First Grade Team will send reading and math instructional materials including their Super Kids reading workbooks, weekly reading stories with comprehension questions, spelling, and reading skill practice. We will use websites such as brainpopjr.com to assign videos, quizzes, and activities for students to continue to learn and practice skills across all subject areas. Students will be able to get on reflexmath.com at home to practice math facts. For students without internet, paper packets of material will be sent home for practice. Google slides will be created to further help with vocabulary and sight word practice. Other online resources such as Education Galaxy or Freckle may also be utilized for reading and math instruction and practice. All usernames and passwords for online programs will be provided to parents. No assignments given during this time will be graded, these assignments will be used for review so that students do not fall behind. Teachers will still be available through Class Dojo and will be posting information and reminders.

### **2nd Grade Plan:**

To continue Reading instruction during this time students will be sent home with their Journeys textbook in order to read the weekly story and have access to current vocabulary. Journey's practice books will be sent home for students to have further practice with grammar, spelling, and reading skill practice. We will use websites such as brainpopjr.com to assign videos, quizzes, and activities for students to continue to learn and practice skills across all subject areas. Students will be able to get on reflexmath.com at home to practice math facts. For students without internet paper packets of material will be sent home for practice. Other online resources such as Education Galaxy or Freckle may also be utilized for reading and math instruction and practice. All usernames and passwords for online programs will be provided to parents. No assignments given during this time will be graded, these assignments will be used for review so that students do not fall behind. Teachers will still be available through Class Dojo and will be posting information and reminders.

Google Classroom links will be provided through Class Dojo story and Class Dojo messages.

**5th Grade Plan:**

We will continue to assign activities to Google Classroom for reading, math and science. Students will have access to Reflex Math and SOL Pass at home for practice. Students who do not have access to the internet at home will be given a printed copy of digital activities. No assignments given during this time will be graded, these assignments will be used for review so that students do not fall behind. Teachers will still be available through Class Dojo and will be posting information and reminders.

Students use clever.com this is a website that stores all student passwords for easy login. Students are able to access Clever through the website and by clicking on "log in as student" in the upper right corner. Students should click on "log in with Google" and enter their school email and password. Logging in through Clever will allow student access to the learning materials listed below. Students have their Google log in information in their assignment books.

## Reading

1. **Google Classroom** → Students use Google Classroom daily. ## Math

3. Freckle → Freckle is a math website that allows students to practice various math skills.
4. Khan Academy → Khan Academy is a website that allows students to practice various math skills and also includes instructional videos.
5. Coach books for students who receive them → Students who receive coach books will be assigned lessons to complete.

1. SOLpass.org → SOLpass.org is a website for practicing all SOL standards. We like to use this website especially for Science. Students may work on specific Science standards, as well take practice SOL tests. There are also Reading and Math tests available for practice.
